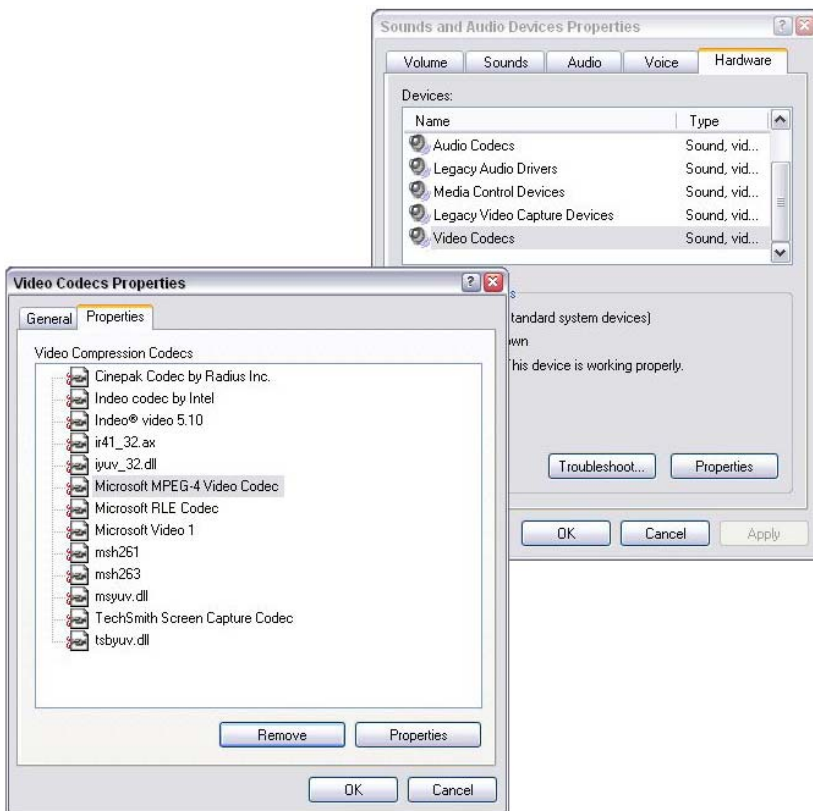
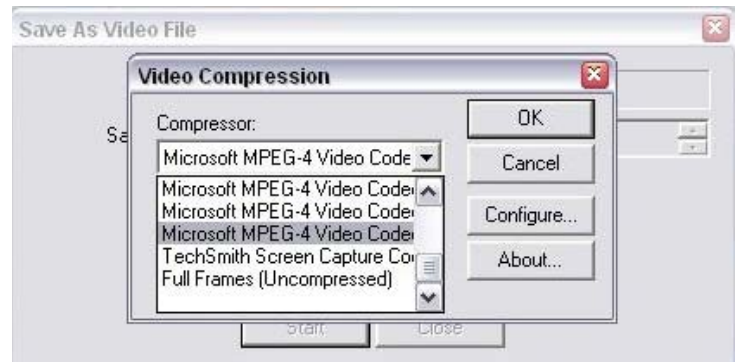


# Tech Tip

## RoadRunner Mobile Digital Video Systems Installation of MPEG 4 Codec

The MPEG-4 video codec is required for viewing and recording .AVI format files. When you are saving a video clip using the .AVI format (for playback on Windows Media Player) you should select the MPEG-4 video codec as listed in Figure on the right.

This video codec should automatically install with the Remote Administrative Software (RAS) and the Hard Disk Player (HDP) Software. If this video codec is not listed when you are saving the file, you can follow the directions to determine it is installed correctly.



### Determining if the Codec is installed properly:

1. Click on **Start** at the bottom left-hand corner of your screen. (Located in the 'task bar')
2. Select **Control Panel**
3. Double-click the icon titled '**Sound and Audio Device**'
4. Select the **Hardware** tab, and highlight **Video Codecs**
5. Select **Properties**, and then click on the **Properties** tab

If "Microsoft MPEG-4 Video Codec" is not included on this list as displayed in the figure to the left, or is included but will not allow you to save video in this format - reinstall the MPEG-4 Codec by downloading from our website:
