Bothell, Wash – June 17, 2014 – The Clark County Public Transit Benefit Area Authority (C-TRAN) has selected the RoadRunner™ on-board video surveillance system and Vehicle Information Management (ViM™) Software from [Apollo Video Technology](http://www.apollovideo.com) (Apollo Video) for its fleet of fixed-route and paratransit vehicles.
